

## China Compulsory Certification (CCC)

### Important Notes:

This information has been compiled from available sources and can be used to help answer requests related to CCC certifications for Hewlett Packard Enterprise (HPE) products. However, the content is subject to change without notice and no guarantee of correctness or completeness can be given.

While the contents of this document can aid understanding and preparing for meeting Chinese regulatory requirements, it must be understood that the only sure solution is to ensure that HPE Sales and Order Management are fully aware of the intention to deploy the products in China and so are able to ensure that suitable models, options and/or localisations are quoted and ordered. Incorrectly ordered products that do not meet the requirements cannot retrospectively be adapted to do so.

The requirements change from time to time, so please ensure you have the latest copy of this document, obtainable from the contact point at the foot of this document.

### China Compulsory Certification (CCC)

For importation and use in China certain types of IT products must have a China Compulsory Certificate (CCC certificate) and carry the CCC mark on the product. Not all IT products fall within CCC scope. Those outside of CCC scope are not required to have CCC marking and certificates. A summary is provided in section "What IT products do NOT need CCC certification?" below. CCC certification requires that a) the product is in compliance with the CCC requirements and b) the manufacturing site for this product has approval for ensuring CCC compliance. Not all manufacturing sites have such approval, so it is important to check before ordering them whether the products require and have CCC certification. This helps to avoid potential shipment delays/holds at Chinese customs. Note that if HPE products are ordered with the Chinese localization option, they will have any necessary CCC certification and marking.

### What IT products do NOT need CCC certification?

Private IT equipment used on business/private trips and following products are excluded from CCC scope:

- Uninterruptible Power Supplies
- Power Distribution Units
- Server Computers with power consumption of more than 1300 Watts
- Mass Storage products (Tape/CD-Drives, HP EVA, MSA Products, etc)
- Wireless Access Points & Networking products, with the following exception:
  - For Switches and Routers the document CNCA Notice No. 187 of 2008 specifies that if all three of the following are true then the Switch or Router is **within** CCC scope and therefore must have a CCC certificate and carry the CCC mark:
    - Powered from 220Vac Mains (including when powered via an external AC/DC adapter)
    - None of the communication interfaces are pluggable modules
    - All the communication interfaces are Ethernet

Note: it can be helpful for networking products that are not in CCC scope to include a data sheet and/or an explanation of what excludes the Switch / Router from CCC scope.

### Notes

1. CCC certificates usually show only Hewlett Packard Enterprise Company's regulatory product identifier (Regulatory Model Number = RMN) instead of the product name. The RMN is printed on the product identification plate and is shown on the EU Declaration of Conformity (DoC) that can be downloaded from Internet at: <http://www.hpe.com/eu/certificates>
3. HPE products ordered with European localization options will be delivered with European power cords and manuals. Exporters **must ensure** that a **certified Chinese Power Cord** accompanies each product shipped to China. Otherwise the shipment may be blocked at Chinese customs and HPE CCC certification may be withdrawn.
4. Regulatory Requirements in China for radio equipment differs from those in Europe. Because radio interface setup is related to the products localisation option, HPE can guarantee product compliance only for the destination country/region identified by actual ordered localization option.
