## Announcement

Web-Based Enterprise Management (WBEM) is an industry wide initiative to unify the management of system, networks, and applications across multiple and diverse vendor environments. The WBEM clients use the mass storage providers to gather information about various subsystems. The WBEM standard enables the WBEM clients to subscribe to indications, and indication consumers to receive indications on the occurrence of events of interest on the managed system.

## HP-UX WBEM nPartition Provider

HP-UX WBEM nPartition provider is used by WBEM client applications to retrieve nPartition-related information on partitionable systems. This product is used by Partition Manager and the partition commands to configure and manage HP systems that support nPartitions. With this component, partitionable systems can be managed both locally and remotely.

This version of the product contains internal defect fixes.
